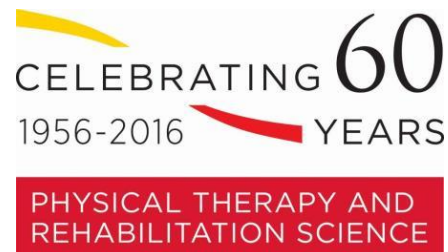

The deadline for proposals is Monday, May 2, 2016 at 5 p.m. The team members identified in the proposal must represent at least three different health profession disciplines.
