PTRS' **Victoria Marchese**, PhD, PT, Associate Professor will be presenting this week's seminar entitled:

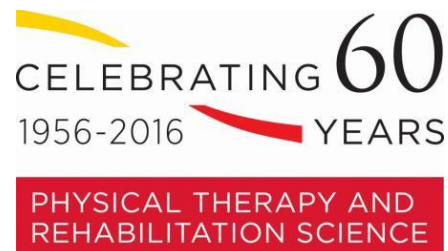
