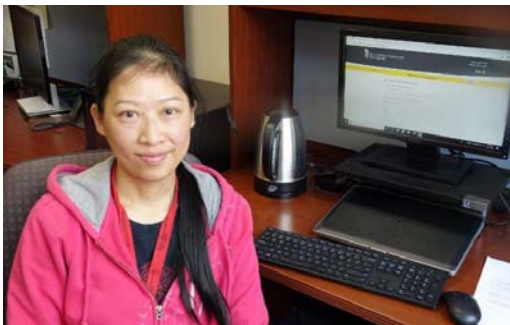

"Timing is Everything:
Circadian Clocks in Behavior and
Disease"

Mark Wu, MD, PhD
Associate Professor in the
Department of Neurology
Johns Hopkins School of Medicine



Dr. Wu will discuss how the circadian clock regulates sleep and arousal. He will provide a broad overview of the mechanisms underlying the circadian timing system, then talk about his own lab's research on this topic in fruit flies and mice. Finally, from his perspective as a sleep medicine physician, he will discuss how these principles relate to human sleep disorders and also touch upon implications for rehabilitation.
