Dr. Mary Rodgers is a faculty mentor for the intensive grant writing workshop (TIGRR) that met last week in Charleston, SC. This 4-1/2 day workshop, sponsored by a grant from the National Center for Medical Rehabilitation Research, provides the expertise and support to be successful at the national level in obtaining rehabilitation research grant support. Mentees for this workshop include junior and mid-level faculty in all rehabilitation research disciplines who are on the cusp of success in NIH-funded or similar research but could benefit from expert mentorship in grant development including choosing best funding source and type of grant from that source. The workshop provides guidance in grant writing, clinical trial design, biostatistics, informatics, collaboration, grantsmanship, budgeting, and career development through lectures and individual consultation.
