Remember that the campus is essentially closed on Thursday and Friday for the Grand Prix. Have a great Labor Day weekend!

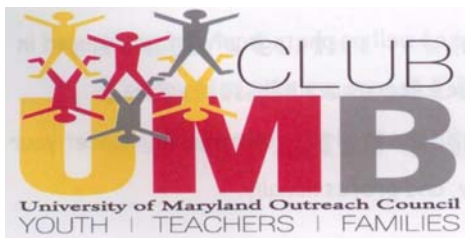
