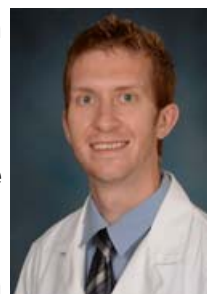

Rehabilitation Science Research Seminar

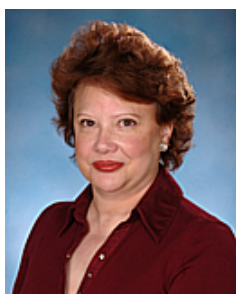
